

Achi is an African game for 2 players. One player has four badgers pieces. The other player has four hedgehog pieces.

The board is a three by three rectangles or squares - a total of nine positions.


The first player to line up three animals in a straight line in any direction wins (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal).

How to Play:

Either player may go first. The players take turns placing one of their four animals on any open rectangle on the board.

After both players have placed all four of their animals on the board, they take turns moving one of their own pieces into the one open rectangle on the board. A piece may only be moved one space at a time - either horizontally, vertically, or diagonally. A piece may not jump another piece.

<u>Winning</u>: The first player to line up three of his or her own animals in a straight line in any direction wins.



You could cut out the badgers and hedgehogs and use them as your pieces.
