Using Illustrations from Books, Etc.

Find some illustrations from books you might have in your classroom or on a programme like Google Images. (Ask for your teacher's permission before you go online and enter Images.)

Use a scanner to copy the images from the books. Try to crop them, so that you only have the small piece of the page you want. Paste them into an article and then write about it. You could even make your own book!

Here are some clip art images that might help you. Ask your teacher to run them off, so that you can scan them and use them in your text. (Scroll down for cartoon animals.)
